To make your
Ankylosaurus Shadow Puppet

You will need:

Scissors

Glue stick or PVA

Sticky Tape

A thin stick or skewer

Coloured translucent cellophane or

Sweet wrappers

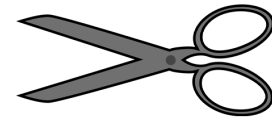
INSTRUCTIONS

to make your Ankylosaurus Shadow Puppet

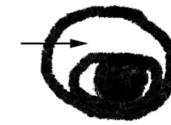
1. Print out Page 1 onto thin card or print onto paper and stick the whole sheet onto some old card like a cereal packet with a Glue Stick or PVA Glue.



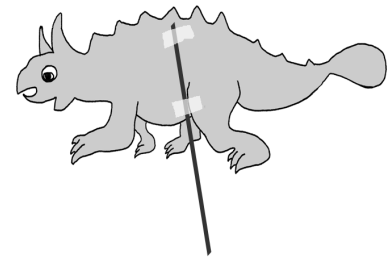
2. Cut out round the outline of the Ankylosaurus and cut off the strip down the long side along the cut line. Glue one side of this strip and fold it along the fold line sticking the two halves together. This can then be used instead of a stick.



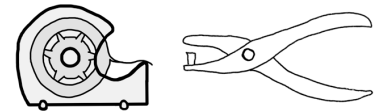
3. Cut out the white part of the Ankylosaurus' eye. If you have any coloured translucent materials or sweetie wrappers [you can test if they are translucent by holding them up to the light so see if you can see through] stick this over the eye to give it some colour.



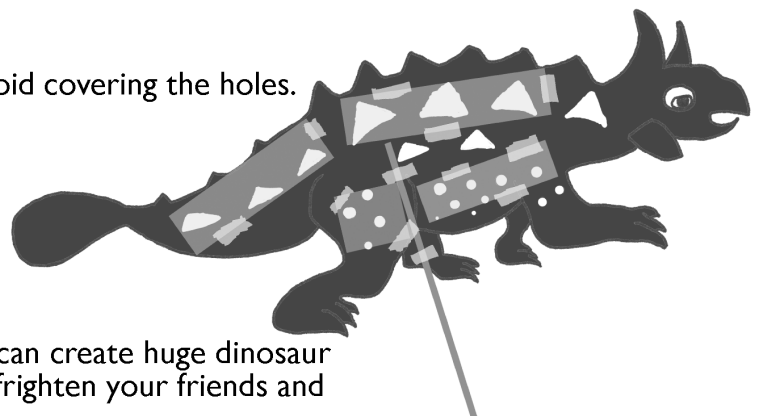
4. You can keep your Ankylosaurus shadow puppet as a simple silhouette by attaching a thin stick with sticky tape. Or use a kebab skewer or the folded strip of cardboard you made at the start.



5. To make your Ankylosaurus more colourful you can carefully cut out the triangle shapes. If you have a hole puncher, you can use this to cut out the circle shapes. Then, in the same way as for the eye, you can put coloured translucent materials behind the holes and stick around the holes with tape.



6. Attach your stick taking care to avoid covering the holes.



7. Using a torch or a phone light you can create huge dinosaur shadows on the walls or ceilings and frighten your friends and family.

Or you can peg up a sheet or piece of paper and create a small shadow puppet dinosaur story.
